Common Cause Georgia www.commoncause.org/georgia/	Promotes transparent and accountable government. They advocate for reforms to ensure fair elections and empower citizens to have a voice in the political process.
Brennan Center for Justice https://www.brennancenter.org	A nonpartisan law and policy institute working to defend democracy and the rule of law. They focus on issues like voting rights, government accountability, and preventing executive overreach.
Center for Constitutional Rights https://ccrjustice.org	CCR uses litigation and advocacy to challenge unconstitutional government practices, defend civil liberties, and promote justice for marginalized communities.
